

# Resource List: Forms for Warrant Recall

If you are thinking of a warrant resolution program, you'll need paperwork to recall outstanding arrest orders for failure to appear. In North Carolina, judicial officials use state and local forms to do that. Rather than starting from scratch, use these forms as a starting point for your jurisdiction.

## Example

In Robeson County, NC, people who miss court can come to the clerk's office and fill out a recall form. If it is the person's first missed court date in a low-level case, the recall is generally granted and the court date is rescheduled. This prevents unnecessary arrests for failure to appear.

If the individual misses court again, they need an attorney to help them file additional recall forms.
