
Scope & Availability of Pretrial Services in North Carolina



Only 36% of North Carolina's 100 counties have any pretrial supervision and support services.



Among counties that have services, there's variation in what's provided. Of the 36 counties with pretrial services programs...

55% | Provide GPS monitoring

Some counties provide GPS monitoring in addition to other services, but seven counties only provide GPS monitoring.

50% | Complete risk assesments

Counties use risk assessments to help determine pretrial conditions.

44% | Make referrals to community services

Case management can include referrals to community resources like behavioral health treatment or affordable housing programs.

27% | Provide court date reminders

Even though reminders are a cost-effective tool to get people to court, they are underutilized. Learn more about options for court date reminders here.
